CONGRATS TO ACHS WRESTLING TEAM on 2nd at Newton

NEWTON — The Arkansas City Bulldogs met their match, but it wasn't in the state of Kansas.

Grand Island, Neb., captured the title Saturday at the 50th Newton Tournament of Champions, sending Ark City home with the second-place plaque.

As is becoming their custom, the Bulldogs sent four grapplers to the championship finals, but just one took home a title. Ark City also had one third, one fourth and three sevenths, earning several points on the backside.

The Bulldogs scored 178 team points, well behind Grand Island's 243, but well ahead of Newton (152 1/2) and Garden City (152) in the 27-team tournament.

Grand Island, the No. 1-ranked tournament and dual team in Nebraska, sent four grapplers to the finals and won three individual titles.

"They are the real deal. And they didn't come to play; they came to wrestle," ACHS coach Greg Buckbee said. "They were impressive. I told their coach I hope they come back, because I love the competition." Read the rest of the story in today's Traveler.
